The Anatomy of Trees

Most of the following supplies may be purchased at the League's art supply store, located in the lobby.

- Canson Colorline Light Grey or Cream Drawing Paper 300gm weight (do NOT get the Canson pastel paper, too soft a surface). Order at Blick online, often NOT carried in stores.
- 2H & 4H pencils (I recommend Staedler Mechanical pencils, 2mm, but others are OK too)
- Sharpener and Kneaded Erasers
- Micron Markers. Black, Burnt Siena or Sepia color. 005, 003 & 02 nibs.
- 3 tubes of watercolor paint: Paynes Grey, Burnt Siena and Chinese White Winsor & Newton watercolor tubes.
- #6, #4 round brushes (W&N series 7 the best, but expensive, other brands cheaper)
- Small palettes and/or China Nest ceramic mixing pans (ceramic is preferable to plastic, ASL store has them)
- A few paper towels and a water vessel, or cup
- A straight edge, either ruler or triangle, at least 12".

*Paper is sold as full sheets, 22 x 30" and so should be cut into smaller pieces, ¼ sheet or into 8 x 10" pieces, the size I use in my own drawings.
